The Story Behind Thanksgiving

Every year, on the fourth Thursday of November, Americans gather with friends and family to indulge in a turkey feast. Thanksgiving is one of the most iconic and cherished American holidays. But how did it come to exist?

The celebration can be traced back to 1620 when a group of English settlers, known as the Pilgrims. arrived on the shores of present-day Massachusetts aboard the Mayflower. Fleeing religious persecution from the Church of England. they sought to start a life in the New World. But their first winter in America was brutal and nearly half of the 102 settlers died.

The romanticised history goes that Pilgrims encountered an English-speaking Native American named Squanto. He and members of the Wampanoag tribe taught the settlers how to fish, cultivate corn, and extract maple from trees. With these skills, the settlers were able to sustain themselves, and in the autumn of 1621 they experienced a bountiful harvest. To express their gratitude, the Pilgrims organized a three-day festivity and invited the Wampanoag tribe, including their leader, Chief Massasoit. The feast included dishes made from the harvested crops. though the meat was probably deer rather than turkey.



In reality, much bloodshed took place both before and after that first feast, and it was Massasoit who negotiated a peace treaty between the settlers and the Wampanoag tribe. This lasted for a decade, but tensions began to simmer again as 25,000 more European colonizers arrived, claiming rights to land, and bringing with them diseases which decimated the native population. Mistrust between the two groups grew and the Native Americans were perceived as the enemy, with horrifying consequences.

Although the 1621 feast is recognized as the first Thanksgiving, the practice of celebrating the harvest was sporadic and varied in nature: some were religious, others more like parties. By the 19th century Thanksgiving began to resemble the modern national holiday. Sarah Josepha Hale, the author of the nursery rhyme "Mary Had a Little Lamb," played a pivotal role. She embarked on a 20-year campaign to establish Thanksgiving as a national holiday, lobbying politicians, presidents, and other influential figures.

In 1863, in the midst of the Civil War, President Abraham Lincoln declared the last Thursday of November as a National Day of Thanksgiving. He hoped the holiday would help unify a nation torn apart by conflict.

Over the years, the traditions and meanings behind Thanksgiving have evolved and diversified. Today, Thanksgiving is a time for reflection, gratitude, and spending time with loved ones (although it's important to acknowledge that mistreatment of Native Americans still goes on). It's also a time for parades, football, and Black Friday sales. Yet despite its transformation over the centuries, the core values of 'giving thanks' remain unchanged and it remains a significant part of American culture.

The Enduring Relevance of War Poets

War poets, as a collective, have been instrumental in capturing the essence of conflict, the human costs of warfare, and the profound emotional experiences of soldiers and civilians alike. These poets, primarily from World War I and II, painted vivid pictures of the battlefield, the trenches, and the emotional toll of war, creating lasting impressions that would shape our understanding of conflict for generations.

During World War I, poets like Wilfred Owen, Siegfried Sassoon, and Rupert Brooke detailed the grim realities of life on the front lines. While World War I poets are perhaps the most renowned, poets from subsequent conflicts have continued the tradition. World War II poets, including Keith Douglas and Alun Lewis, grappled with the vast scale of the conflict and

the devastation wrought by the atom bomb and concentration camps.

Today, the legacy of war poetry is more relevant than ever. As the world grapples with new forms of conflict, including cyber warfare, drone strikes, and ideological battles, the need for voices to humanize and critique these events remains important.

Brian Turner, who served in Iraq, tackles issues of PTSD, the civilian cost in modern warfare, and the mental turmoil soldiers experience when reintegrating into civilian life. Turner's *Here, Bullet* is a raw, visceral look into the Iraq war, encapsulating the tension and unpredictability that modern soldiers face. Poets like Dunya Mikhail, an Iraqi expatriate, write of the effects of war on the homeland, and bridge the gap between soldier and civilian experiences.

Today, warfare and its aftermath can be relayed around the world instantly. Poetry offers a space for reflection, allowing readers to consider the personal experiences behind the headlines. Through evocative imagery and emotional depth, war poetry humanizes the dehumanized, reminding us of the shared humanity that binds us, even in times of conflict.

War poets hold a mirror to society, forcing us to confront the realities of conflict and the profound

impact it has on individuals and communities. Their works serve as both a cautionary tale and a call to compassion, urging current and future generations to seek paths of peace and understanding. As global conflicts continue to evolve, the voices of war poets remain an essential tool in making sense of the chaos.



Benjamin Huntsman

If you visit Kelham Island Museum in Sheffield, you can see a longcase or grandfather clock from the 1740s which was the first manufactured object in the world to contain crucible cast steel. It was made by clockmaker and steelmaker Benjamin Huntsman (1704 – 1776). Huntsman's work was crucial to the development of the steel industry in South Yorkshire and his influence spread worldwide.

Huntsman was from a Quaker family of religious dissenters and became a clock, lock and toolmaker in Doncaster. He was always looking to improve the quality of his clock mechanisms to help make them more robust and accurate. He was also (according to Encyclopaedia Britannica) sometimes asked to carry out experimental eye surgery, presumably due to his expertise with precision instruments!

Huntsman used coke as opposed to coal or charcoal to attain the high temperature required to melt blister steel and dissolve iron. This process created steel of a much more consistent quality than previously. The use of fluxes (purifying agents) also enabled impurities to be skimmed off. As Huntsman's steel was so pure it also needed less reheating and hammering by a blacksmith, which had previously been required to achieve a similar end. Indeed, it also meant that Huntsman's steel could be cast (that is where the liquid steel is poured into a mould which is then broken away or ejected after the cast object has cooled into shape).

Huntsman's crucible steel commenced the drive towards the mass production of good quality steel and was a key to the unlocking of Britain's potential as the first industrial nation. It is not surprising that our region became famed for it, especially in terms of cutlery, machines and tools.

Like many successful innovators Huntsman was less good at 'the paperwork' and failed to patent the invention of his process. His secret was copied by Samuel Walker (1742-1793), whose family-owned Walker Ironworks famously produced cannons, some of which still sit outside the old Rotherham Town Hall. How the Walkers made the discovery remains a mystery.

Huntsman's operations moved to Attercliffe in 1770 and he died in 1776. You can still visit his grave in Hilltop Cemetery by Attercliffe Chapel. He was succeeded in business by his son William.

It is important to keep knowledge and understanding of our local history and industrial heritage alive. Clifton Park Museum and the various Sheffield Museums fulfil that function very ably. Why not visit with the children or grandchildren during the next school holidays?

St. Andrew's Day - Nov 30th

How did St Andrew, who never set foot in Scotland, become its patron saint?

Born in Bethsaida on the Sea of Galilee, Andrew was the brother of Peter and both were fishermen before becoming disciples of Jesus. St Andrew was known for his strong faith and fervent devotion, and is credited as the first

apostle and with introducing his brother to Jesus. His missionary journeys took him to areas like Greece, Turkey, and possibly parts of modern-day Russia and Poland.

However, what ties St. Andrew to Scotland is not his life but the manner of his martyrdom. After Jesus died, Andrew

continued to preach about Jesus and his teachings. The Roman rulers took exception to this and crucified him for his beliefs on an X-Shaped cross. The story goes that Andrew chose to be crucified this way because he deemed himself unworthy to be crucified on the same type of cross as had been used for Jesus.

This symbol was ultimately adopted for the national flag of Scotland.

The connection with Scotland deepened with legends suggesting that some of St Andrew's relics were brought to Scotland by St Regulus. He was said to be guided by a divine vision to take these relics to the "ends of the earth" for

safekeeping. His journey led him to the east coast of Scotland, to a place now known as St. Andrews, which made the town a major pilgrimage site in medieval times.

St Andrew has been celebrated in Scotland for over one thousand years, with

feasts being held in his honour as far back as the year 1000 AD. However, it wasn't until 1320, when Scotland's independence was declared with the signing of The Declaration of Arbroath, that he officially became Scotland's patron saint.



Do you remember those eight "HEAT OR EAT" articles I wrote last year? As the weather cools down, it is time for a quick recap of how to cut heating bills.

Insulation is the key. On a cold day, wear a warm hat to stop your body heat escaping from your head. The same is true for thick gloves and socks. A body warmer insulates your core, and your heart pumps that warm blood around your body. Similarly, heat rises and a loft that has insufficient insulation will allow precious, expensive heat to escape. Ill-fitting windows and doors, holes in the skirting board and gaps between bare boards all let heat out and use more energy to maintain the temperature set on your thermostat.



A few quick suggestions

Open thick curtains to let the sun in, but close them after dark for insulation.

Turn the room thermostat down a degree or two, and dress appropriately.

Turn radiators off in unoccupied rooms and keep the door shut.

Refrigeration uses a lot of energy so open the fridge door sparingly.

Insulate your hot water cylinder.

Use low energy bulbs and turn off unnecessary lights

Slow cookers, microwaves and air fryers are all cheaper ways to cook than a conventional oven.

Leaving many appliances on standby is costing you money - turn them off!

Place cold tap water in a large jug, to come to an ambient temperature. It will take much less time to boil

Fill a flask with boiling water that you can use throughout the day.

Each action taken will save pennies on your energy bill, and then hopefully the pounds will take care of themselves. One last thing. If you are feeling chilly it is quite uplifting to dance your way around the chores to some music that sets your feet a tapping!

Open handbags and purses, and hands and bags full of goodies are an open invitation to a thief. And remember, a thief may well be someone you walk past in the street and may not even notice.


You might have bags full of shopping that you want to drop off to the car before going back to finish off your purchases. If you do, it is advisable to

Trees have graced our planet for over 370 million years, offering a range of benefits that render them indispensable to life as we know it. National Tree Week (25th November-3rd December) celebrates the many reasons why trees are the champions of the natural world and why we should all plant a tree today.

Every school student learns that trees play a pivotal role in the process of carbon dioxide reduction. Through photosynthesis they absorb carbon dioxide and release oxygen, a vital element for most organisms on Earth. A mature leafy tree can produce as much oxygen in a season as 10 people inhale in a year. By cleansing the air, trees essentially act as the lungs of our planet.

Trees are formidable warriors in the battle against climate change. By absorbing and storing carbon dioxide, they mitigate the greenhouse effect, helping to cool our warming planet. Forests worldwide store more than 296 gigatons of carbon, acting as crucial carbon sinks.

Forests, rich with trees of all kinds, are hotspots of biodiversity. They provide habitat, food, and protection to countless species, from the tallest giraffes nibbling on treetop leaves in Africa, to the smallest beetles burrowing in the bark of rainforest trees. Without trees, many of these habitats would be lost, leading to massive declines in biodiversity.

Trees play an essential role in maintaining the health and integrity of our soil. Their root systems anchor the soil, preventing erosion, particularly in areas susceptible to landslides or during heavy rainfall. Furthermore, fallen leaves decompose and enrich the soil with nutrients, promoting a healthy ground ecosystem.

Trees significantly influence the water cycle. They absorb rainfall and produce water vapour through transpiration, which is then released into the atmosphere. This process not only aids in cloud formation

but also ensures that water is recycled back into our environment through rain, maintaining a balanced ecosystem.

In urban environments, trees act as natural air conditioners. Their shade cools down streets and cities, reducing the need for air conditioning in nearby buildings and lowering energy costs. Moreover, trees absorb and block sunlight, reducing the heat island effect common in urban areas.

Recent studies have highlighted the health benefits associated with trees. Proximity to green spaces with trees, has been linked to reduced stress, lower depression rates, and increased physical activity. Furthermore, trees filter out pollutants, providing cleaner air and reducing the rates of respiratory illnesses.

The multifaceted roles trees play in sustaining life on Earth means that we should be protecting them and planting more. In a rapidly changing world they are the stewards of our world and it is our duty to recognize their value, protect them, and ensure they continue to thrive for generations to come.

YourRecipe

PEAR AND CHOCOLATE PUDDING CAKE

Prep: 20 mins Cook: 40 mins Serves: 8

Ingredients

85g butter, plus 1 tbsp extra for tin 85g golden caster sugar, plus extra for tin 85g gluten-free dark chocolate, broken into pieces

1 tbsp brandy

3 eggs, separated

85g hazelnuts or almonds, toasted and ground in a food processor

4 very ripe pears peeled, halved, and cored loing sugar, for dusting



Grease the sides of a 25cm loose-bottomed cake tin and line the base with baking parchment. Sprinkle in 2 tbsp caster sugar and swirl it around to coat the base and sides, then tip out any excess.

Preheat the oven to 180°C/fan 160°C/gas 4. Melt the chocolate and butter in a bowl over a pan of hot water, remove from the heat, stir in the brandy and leave to cool.



Whisk the egg yolks with the caster sugar in a large bowl until pale and thick; then fold into the cooled chocolate along with the ground hazelnuts or almonds.

In a separate bowl, with a clean whisk, beat the egg whites until they reach a soft peak (don't over beat). Stir a spoonful into the chocolate mix, then

carefully fold in the rest.

Spoon the mixture into the prepared tin. Level it off, then arrange the pears over the mixture, cut side down. Bake for about 40 mins until the pears are soft and the cake is cooked all the way through. Leave to cool in the tin for five minutes before releasing, then place on a rack to cool completely.

Dust with icing sugar and serve with crème fraîche.






