

Have a Nap-py New Year!

In a society where napping is often misconstrued as laziness, there's a growing body of scientific evidence underscoring the benefits of this habit. Research on napping has historically been mixed, and this ambiguity has made experts

cautious about recommending naps. However, recent studies have refined our understanding.

Short naps have been shown to significantly enhance certain cognitive functions such as memory, information-processing speed and vigilance. Research at the National University of Singapore emphasizes the mood-improving effects of napping, noting that even a brief 10-minute nap can be refreshing. A nap lasting around 30 minutes is considered optimal, as it predominantly involves light sleep, making it easier to wake up refreshed. The researchers advise against napping after 5 pm to avoid disrupting nighttime sleep patterns.

Longer naps can have downsides. Moving into deeper sleep stages can lead to sleep inertia, a state of grogginess upon waking, which many of us find unpleasant. Moreover, naps exceeding 30 minutes have been linked to health issues like obesity and metabolic syndrome. This association, however, is probably more indicative of underlying health conditions rather than being a direct result of prolonged napping.

Interestingly, excessive napping can also be a symptom of illnesses, such as Alzheimer's disease or increased brain inflammation. If you regularly need lengthy naps (over an hour) or multiple naps per day, you might have a health problem and should consult your GP.

After looking at the research, I don't feel guilty about my 20-minute naps any more. They leave me feeling alert and productive, which aligns with the scientific understanding of the benefits of brief naps. When done correctly, napping can be a valuable tool for enhancing cognitive function and overall well-being. I would go as far as to say that in today's fast-paced world, napping is a valuable survival tool.

The celebration of New Year on January 1st is a practice steeped in history, reflecting significant shifts in calendar systems. In the United Kingdom this tradition, as we know it today, has its roots in the transition from the Julian to the Gregorian calendar.

The Julian calendar, introduced by Julius Caesar in 45 BCE, was a reform of the Roman calendar. It was designed to more accurately reflect the solar year - the time it takes Earth to orbit the Sun. This calendar instituted January 1st as the start of the year, aligning with the civil Roman year's beginning. However, the Julian calendar had a significant flaw: it miscalculated the solar year by 11 minutes. This error meant that the calendar gained a day every 128 years, causing seasonal drift over centuries.

To correct this accumulating discrepancy, Pope Gregory XIII introduced the Gregorian calendar in 1582. This calendar was more

precise in its calculation of the solar year and was gradually

adopted across Europe, with the United Kingdom and its colonies making the switch in 1752. The change necessitated an adjustment: September 2, 1752, was followed by September 14, 1752, to

realign dates with the seasons.

Both Julian and Gregorian calendars incorporated the concept of a leap year to maintain alignment with the Earth's revolutions around the Sun. The Julian calendar added a leap day every four years, but this overcompensated for the actual solar year length. The Gregorian reform refined this by introducing a rule: a year is a leap year if it is divisible by four, but century years must be divisible by 400 to be leap years. This system ensures greater accuracy in keeping the calendar year synchronized with the astronomical year.

Death by Mobile Phone

It is 20 years since the ban on "interactive" handheld mobile phone use in vehicles. Since then there has been a profound change in the sophistication of mobile phones and their use. More than ever before, people consider them essential to daily life. Using a phone whilst driving, however, is more likely to cause an accident than drink-driving, yet people continue to do it. In a 2019 survey for *Brake*, the road safety charity and *Direct Line*, 4% of drivers (over 1.5 million licence holders) claimed it was not at all distracting to message or text on a phone whilst driving.

How many of you have answered a call quickly at red traffic lights or while held up in road works have checked your text messages or have sent a brief one yourself: "Stuck in traffic, running late"? ALL ARE ILLEGAL.

In 2022 the law was tightened up. Now you can't illuminate the screen, check the time, check notifications, unlock a phone, receive or reject a call - or use a map app unless your phone is in a cradle.

The penalties have got stricter. Now you will be fined £200 fixed penalty and get 6 points on

your licence plus disqualification if you passed your test within 2 years.

There has been a growing body of scientific evidence pointing to the dangers of hands-free. Research has shown that hands-free is equally as dangerous in terms of distraction. A driver using hands-free is four times more likely to be involved in a collision. Distracted drivers are far less likely to notice hazards.

There are many tragic examples now of fatalities involving car collisions and cars hitting pedestrians where drivers have been prosecuted for death by dangerous driving caused by the use of a mobile phone.

Think hard before you check your phone – switch it to silent, switch it off, or put it in an inaccessible place until you reach your destination. If using hands-free, which is still legal, think hard about the risks involved.

The Colourful History of Textile Dyeing

As I watched my daughter unwrap a bright rainbow scarf on Christmas day I suddenly thought how much we all take colour for granted. It hasn't always been this way. For many years, clothing of everyday folk was plain, mainly browns and greys.

The history of textile dyes spans thousands of years. Ancient civilizations extracted colours from natural sources such as the Indigofera plant, famous for its deep blue indigo hue.

The Romans prized Tyrian purple, extracted from the murex sea snail. The crimson dye, carmine, obtained from cochineal insects, was used initially by the Aztecs but was later introduced to Europe by the Spanish.

These natural dyes were also a symbol of social status and economic power, associated with royalty and wealth. The labourintensive production process made them expensive and therefore accessible only to the elite.

By the Middle Ages the growth of trade routes along with increased exploration and colonization brought European countries into

contact with new dye sources, such as logwood and brazilwood, leading to an increased colour palette.

During the Industrial Revolution, the growing textile industry increased the demand for dyes. In 1856 an English chemist, William Henry Perkin, accidentally discovered mauveine, the first synthetic dye. This event marked a turning point in the dye industry. Synthetic dyes were cheaper, more consistent in quality, offered a wider range of colours, and were more colourfast. They democratised fashion, making colourful clothing accessible to the masses.

During the 20th century, the environmental impact of dye manufacturing and use became increasingly evident. The release of untreated dye effluents into

water bodies caused significant pollution, prompting a movement towards more sustainable and eco-friendly dyeing methods. As we move forward, the challenge lies in balancing the aesthetic and functional demands of dyes with the urgent need for environmental sustainability and responsibility.

Safe Winter Motoring

These days domestic garages tend to be used for many purposes other than to park vehicles. So at this time of year, with the onset of frosty and snowy weather, we may find ourselves with frozen windows that need thawing out before we can use our car or van to get to work or social events.

Many drivers do not like using spray de-icers, mainly on environmental grounds. Sometimes the plastic scraper is not very effective, especially if the ice is thick. So warming up the car engine and using the electric de-misters on the rear window and (if fitted) on the windscreen are the quickest ways to get going.

Once the engine has been started, please make sure you stay with your vehicle. The chances of the vehicle being stolen are therefore greatly reduced. Also remember that if your car is parked on the road and left unattended with the engine running, you will be committing a road traffic offence. Stay with your vehicle.

These days we don't often get untreated main roads when we are out driving, but untreated side roads can be hazardous. Remember when driving in icy and snowy

conditions to lower engine revs with a slightly higher than normal gear. Try to let the clutch out slowly when changing gears. Keep your speed down and as much as possible try to avoid using the brakes. If you do get stuck in the snow or on ice, please don't try to race the engine in low gear to get you out of trouble, it only makes it worse.

Also, don't forget to take a mobile phone.

Consider keeping some spare warm clothing in the car. And a flask of tea/coffee/soup just in case - something to keep body and soul together. A long-handled shovel in the boot is also another good idea to adopt. Maybe the odd bit of old carpet or similar material to put under the driving wheel(s). And please don't forget to tell someone where and when you are going, when you expect to get there and when you are expected to return. If things do go wrong and you get into trouble it makes it so much easier to get you

rescued.

The Importance of Fog Lights

Foggy mornings are common at this time of year. Even though car lighting technology is rapidly advancing, fog lights remain a crucial aspect of vehicle safety, especially under UK law. This guide highlights the importance, usage, and regulations surrounding fog lights.

UK law mandates that all cars have a rear fog light, while front fog lights are optional and often serve as an aesthetic feature as well as a safety tool. Some modern cars have replaced front fog lights with bright LED daytime running lights (DRLs), which help in making the vehicle more visible to others.

Fog lights typically operate separately from the

main lights. A symbol on the instrument cluster usually indicates when fog lights are active. It's important to note that most fog lights turn off automatically with the car's ignition or lights.

Fog lights should be used in severely restricted visibility conditions like fog, heavy rain, or snow. They are intended to make the car visible, not to light the way. Main headlights should be used in fog, with fog lights as an additional aid when visibility is extremely poor. The UK's Highway Code specifies using fog lights when visibility is under 100 meters. A good rule of thumb is whether you can see the next streetlight up the road.

Fog lights should be switched off when visibility improves to prevent dazzling other road users and to prevent rear fog lights from obscuring brake lights as they are brighter than standard taillights.

While fog lights might seem less essential with improved car lighting, they play

a vital role in enhancing visibility and safety in poor weather conditions.
Understanding and adhering to their correct usage as per the Highway Code is crucial for safe driving and ensuring the

safety of other road users.

New Year - New Garden

When the outlook is cold and bleak pour a mug of hot chocolate and start planning for Spring.

We'd all like a dream garden right? But is your dream garden the same as your neighbour's? Probably not. Whether you're designing a garden from scratch or remodelling the one you have there is no 'one size

fits all' garden design. Unless you can afford to have the professionals in - and they can be worth every penny - you'll need to apply a lot of thought to the process. We've created this brief guide to give you a kick-start.

Budget Be clear about this. There's no point coming up with a grand design if you can't afford to carry it through.

Time If you work full time and have an active social life you'll need to think 'low-maintenance.'

Consult your family What do they want from the garden? Small children will want a space to play; the adults might want a space to eat and entertain; you might want to grow your own veg, or herbs.

Is it possible? How big is the garden? How much sun does it get? It's no good planning lots of flowerbeds if the garden is in deep shade for most of the day. How can you compromise so that everyone is happy?

What shape is your garden? Each shape presents its own challenge. Square can be boring and needs to be broken up using lots of curves. Long and thin can be disguised by dividing it into



imaginary rooms linked by a winding path. Slopes can be challenging, especially if they're steep but could be made into a feature by terracing or incorporating a waterfall.

Firm up your ideas Do you want grass or paving? How much should be devoted to borders or flowerbeds? Will

you need a new fence or would you rather have a natural hedge? Will you need professional help with any hard landscaping?

Make a scale plan Measure all the major distances in your garden. It's a good idea to take them from a fixed point, such as the corner of your house. Try 1/4 or 1/2 inch = 1 foot if you're not metric and 1cm or 2cm = 1m if you are. When complete make several copies and draw all your ideas on to the plans until you come up with one you really like. Because it's to scale you can now carry out your plans with confidence.

General Tips...

Look at the plants which thrive in your neighbours' gardens. Chances are they'll do well in yours too.

Don't be scared of garden designers. A good one can maximise the potential of your plot. You can still do all the work yourself at your leisure if the budget is tight.

Get help with hard landscaping if you don't have the expertise. You'll save money and heartache in the long run!

YourRecipe

Beef Stroganoff with Herb Pasta

Preparation time 10 mins (+ 45 mins freezer time) Cooking time 20 mins Serves 4

Ingredients

400g beef rump steak, trimmed

- 1 tbsp butter
- 1 tbsp olive oil

300g small button mushrooms 400g pappardelle pasta

- 3 shallots, finely chopped
- 1 tbsp plain flour
- 300ml beef stock
- 1 tbsp Dijon mustard
- 1 tbsp tomato purée
- 3 tbsp crème fraiche ½ x 20q pack flat-leaf parsley, chopped.

Method

Freeze the beef for 45 mins before you begin. This makes it easy to slice really thinly. Season well.



Melt half the butter and half the oil in a large, non-stick frying pan. Turn the heat up and quickly sear the beef in batches until browned on both sides. Remove the meat and set aside. Repeat with the mushrooms, then set aside with the beef. Boil the pasta.

Add the remaining butter and oil to the pan and

soften the shallots for a few mins. Stir in the flour for 1 min, then gradually add in the stock, stirring continuously to prevent lumps. Simmer to allow it to think for 5 mins, then stir in the mustard, tomato purée, crème fraîche and seasoning. Simmer for one more minute, then return the beef and mushrooms to the pan.

Drain the pasta, toss with half the chopped parsley, season, then serve with the creamy stroganoff, sprinkled with the remaining parsley.

Perfect by Rachel Joyce




